Student Council Shri Krishna Janmashtami 2022 Event Report

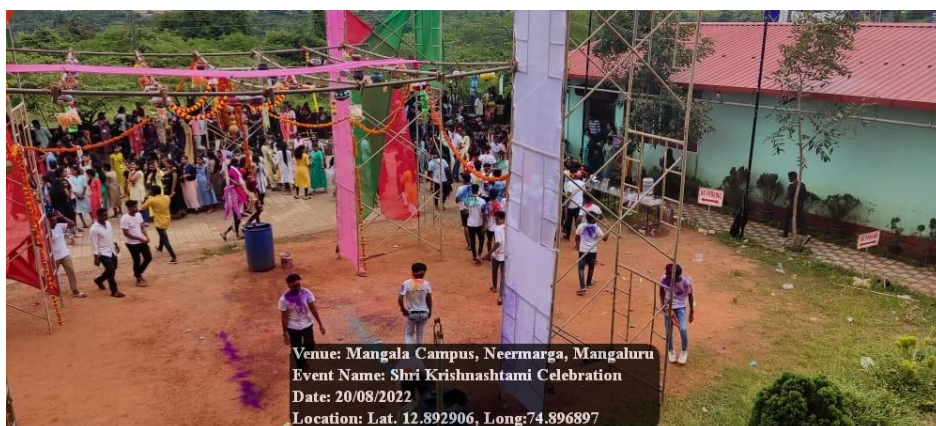
