The NSS Unit in association with Department of Optometry, Mangala college of Allied Health Sciences conducted a School Vision Screening at SDM Mangala Jyothi Integrated School in Vamanjoor, Mangalore on 6th June 2022. The camp was conducted by IInd and IIIrd year B.Sc. Optometry students. As part of the event, Vision screening was done for school children up to 10th standard.

The aim of the screening was to identify any visual problems among children and provide appropriate interventions. The screening included visual acuity tests, refraction, and screening for common eye diseases. 14 B.Sc. Optometry students participated in the program.

The B.Sc. students who conducted the screening were trained in various aspects of vision screening and were supervised by qualified Optometrists. They were able to identify several cases of refractive errors, and the children were provided with free spectacles and medications, as required.

The School Vision Screening was a great success and helped to promote better eye health and eye care among school children. The NSS Unit in association with the Department of Optometry at Mangala college of Allied health sciences aims to continue organizing such camps in the future and work towards improving the eye health of the community.
