


















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#### FACULTY (TEACHER) FEEDBACK ANALYSIS AND INTERPRETATION REPORT 2020-21


Q 2. Academic initiatives helped you to bridge the gap between hospital and academia




Q 3 The faculties were easy to approach for guidance and support
