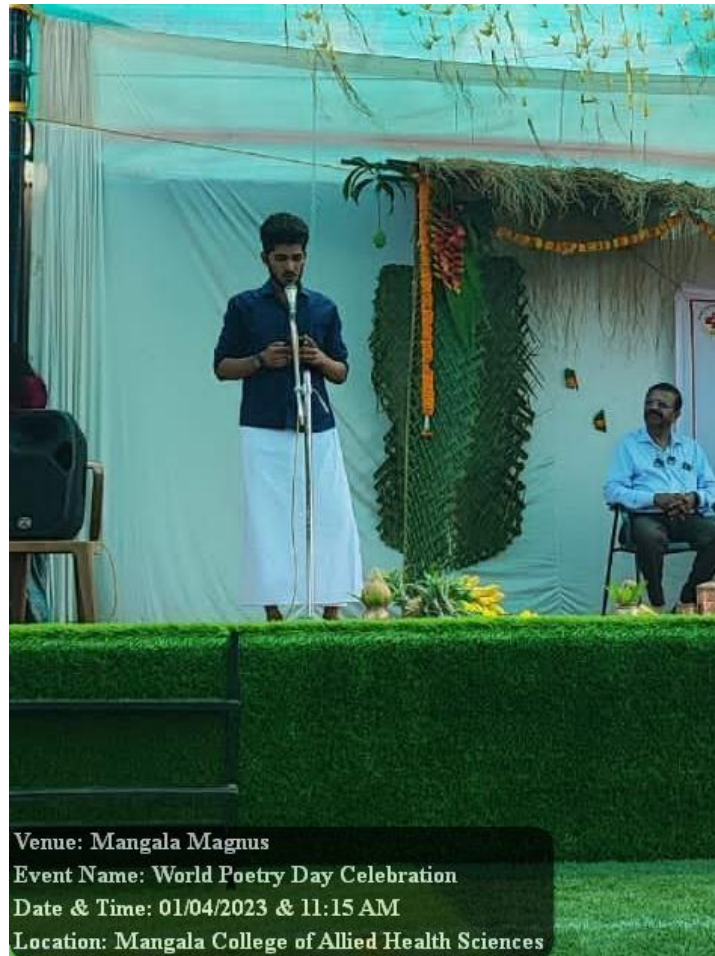
ARTS CLUB EVENT REPORT WORLD POETRY DAY CELEBRATION
