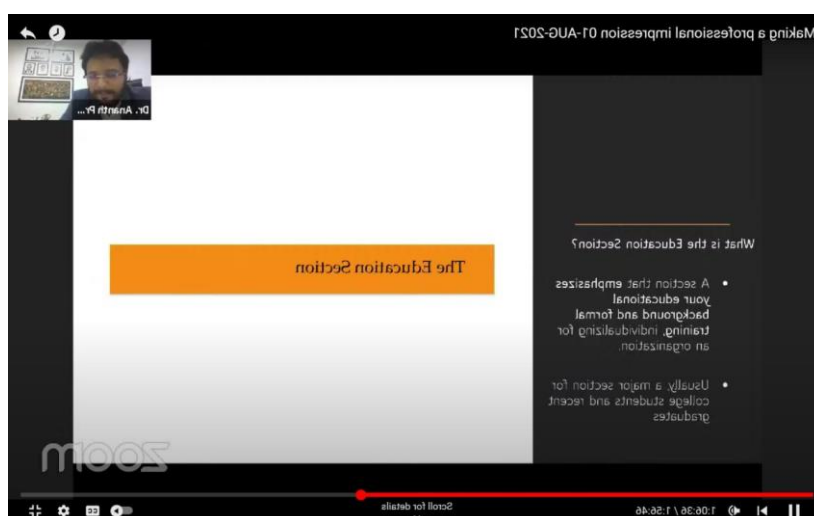

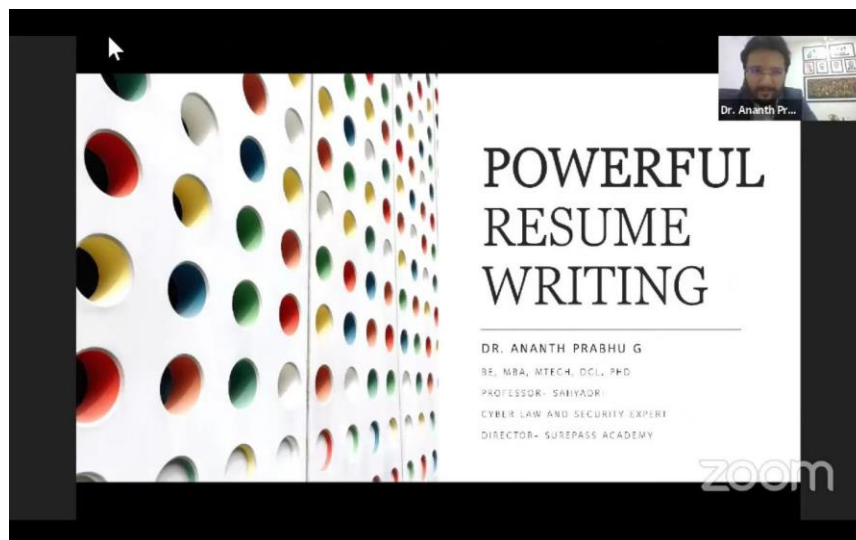
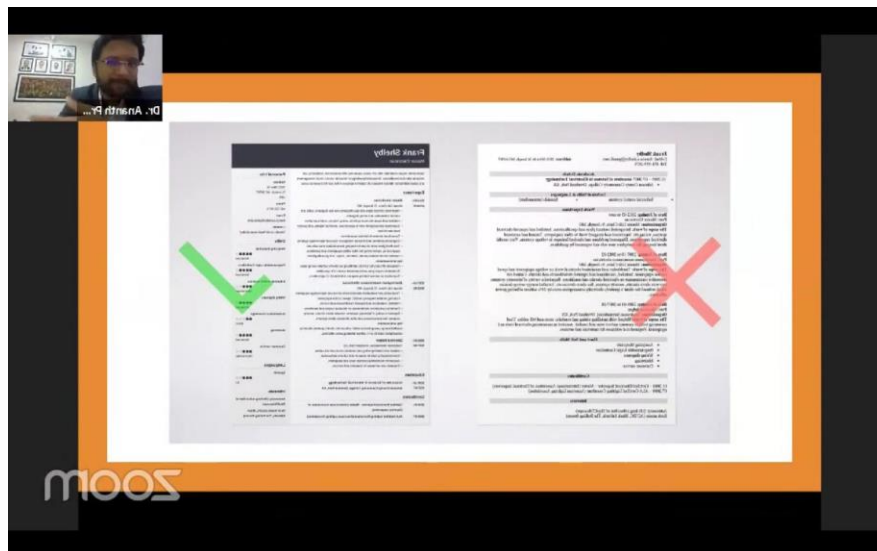
Program started with a warm welcome to the resource person Dr. Ananth Prabhu G.

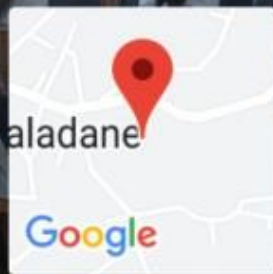

Ms. Saleeka Shama, member of IDP gave information about job opportunities, how to apply and details about documents required.

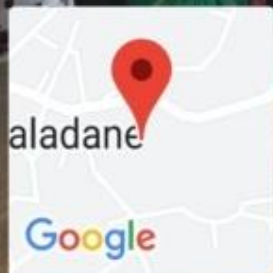
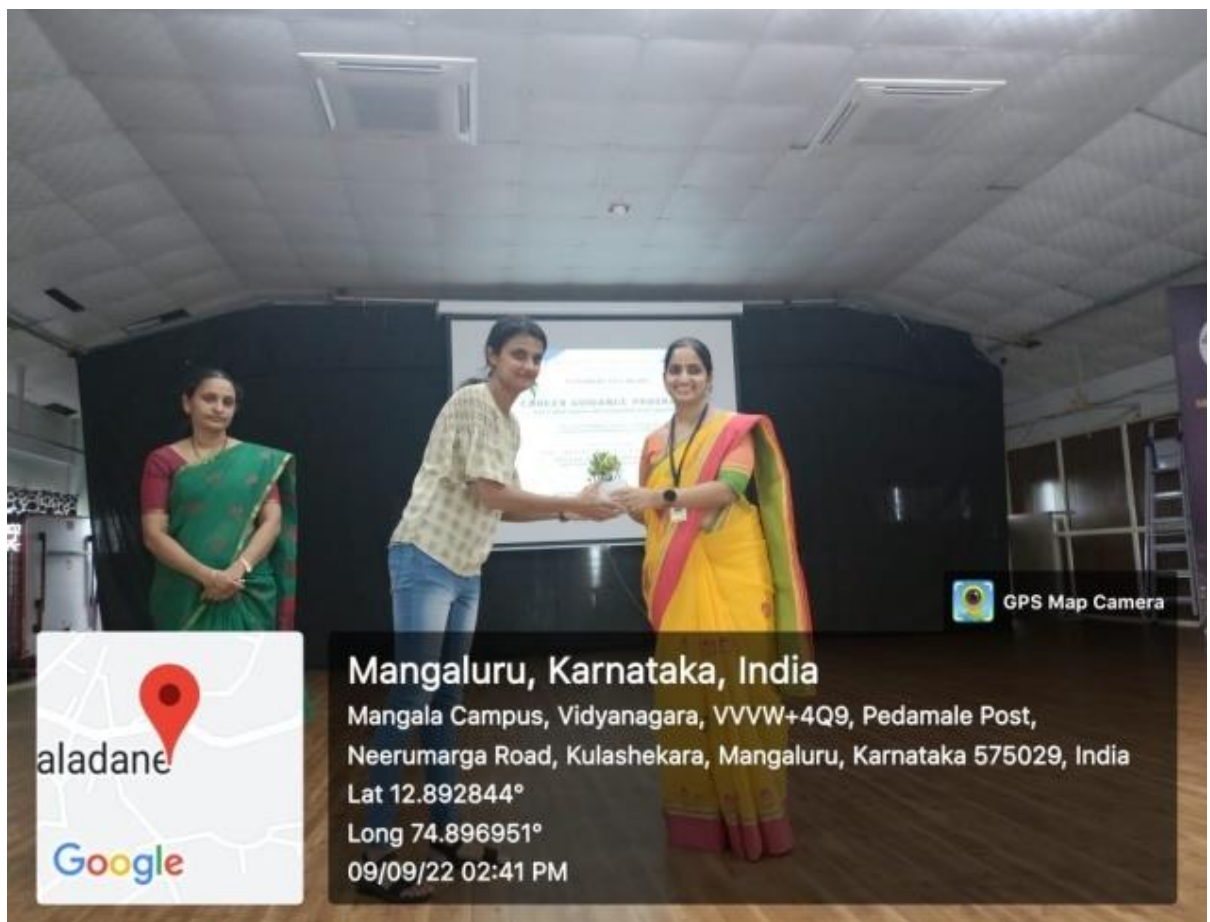
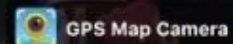
